Semuliki NP			435 Bird Species; has 63 mammals
Kibale NP			325 bird species; 60 Mammals;
Murchison Falls NP	Size 3,840 sq. km		one of the two oldest national parks gazetted in 1952 ; has 450 Bird Species
Kidepo NP	1442sq km		has about 80 Mammals; 465 Bird Species 58 being raptors and 14 only found in Kidepo
Mount Elgon	1,145 sq. km,	Wagai Peak is at 4,321 metres above sea level	305 bird species, 24 mammals that can easily be seen
